World Sailing Olympic Qualification Event validity standards for quota allocation

Qualification Events must comply with the following criteria:

a. Shall complete at least six (6) races in an Event for the results to be used for Olympic qualification

b. A qualification Event shall:

1. Have at least one more unqualified NOC than boat quota places offered to be a valid qualification event e.g., to offer one (1) boat quota place there must be two (2) non-qualified NOCs participating, to offer two (2) boat quota places there must be three (3) non-qualified nations participating and so on; OR
2. be a valid qualification event if one (1) boat from an entered NOC finished in the top 90% of boats in the Event at the 2023 Sailing World Championships (regardless of the composition of the final 10% of the boats), that NOC is eligible for qualification if there are insufficient entries from other non-qualified NOCs.

c. Shall meet the World Sailing Olympic Qualification Event Requirements
